HOTT seeks a permanent full-time Caretaker to work at all of its properties. The position offers a competitive salary, and health benefits.

Overview of Position:

Reporting to the Maintenance Coordinator, the Caretaker contributes to quality living environments consistent with HOTT's mission and values. Responsible for all on-site cleaning, grounds keeping, garbage and recycling handling and minor repairs at all of HOTT's properties in order to keep excellent health and safety conditions and a well-maintained appearance across the portfolio. Works collaboratively with HOTT staff, tenants and community resources.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- cleaning common areas of buildings and the office, as well as individual units on move-out
- maintaining grounds including: seeding, watering and cutting grass; removing fall leaves; keeping hard surfaces free of snow and ice
- inspecting fire systems and replacing batteries
- running load tests on emergency generator
- restocking, distributing and replacing supplies and parts including: cleaning supplies, light bulbs, and plumbing and hardware parts
- applying pest control products and protocols, and monitoring buildings for presence of pests
- performing minor repairs
- regular on-call pager duties, shared with other staff on a rotational basis

Requirements:

Excellent cleaning, caretaking and handyperson skills

Competence in operating caretaking and grounds keeping equipment

Very good time management and organizational skills

Strong communications skills and proficiency in English – both verbal and written

Basic computer literacy

Ability to lift and carry up to 30 kg

Valid driver's license and access to a reliable vehicle at all times

Resides in the GTA due to on-call duties

Self-motivated and a team player

Sensitivity and respect for HOTT's tenants and neighbours
