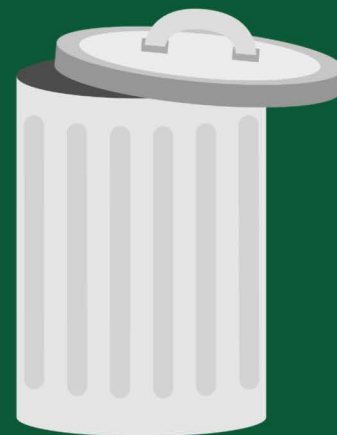
Environmental Program Coordinator: Summer Position

TIPS TO BEAT THE HEAT!

Limit the use of oven or stove, they make the space hotter.



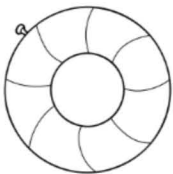

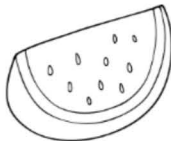
